



## YOUR APPOINTMENT INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING:

- + A comprehensive assessment of physical and mental health, a complete lifestyle review and a detailed family history to establish risk factors
- + A thorough physical examination by one of our experienced physicians
- + Comprehensive Blood Tests including:
  - Full blood count (Haemoglobin, white cell count & platelets)
  - Liver function
  - Kidney function
  - Electrolytes
  - Full lipid panel (Total cholesterol, HDL/LDL/Triglycerides)
  - Marker of inflammation
  - Ferritin (marker of Iron levels)
  - Fasting glucose to identify diabetes
  - Bone profile including calcium levels
  - Uric acid (marker of gout)
  - Vitamin D
  - Vitamin B-12 & Folate profile
  - Thyroid function
- + Urine Analysis (10 parameters) & Expanded Urine testing
- + ECG A non-invasive test that provides information about your cardiac health
- Vitalograph lung function (infection control permitting)
- + Female:
  - Breast examination
  - Contraceptive, Pregnancy and Menopause advice
  - HPV Cervical Screen
  - Ovarian cancer tumor marker (Ca-125)
- + Male:
  - Testicular and Prostate examination
  - Prostate cancer tumor marker PSA

On arrival at The London General Practice, the Practice Nurse, will perform a series of tests including:

- + Height and weight- to calculate BMI
- + Blood Pressure to check for hypertension
- + Urinalysis to check the urine for ten different parameters
- + ECG to analyse heart rythm and check heart function
- + Vitalograph sprometer to test lung function
- + Visual test to check eyesight and for color blindness
- + Stressometer to assess your current mental health

Following your tests, your doctor will undertake a thorough physical examination and talk through your medical history, and that of your family to identify potential problems.

Once all of the test results are available, you will receive a detailed report giving you a clear understanding of your current health.

Your Doctor will also give you advice and guidance on how to maintain your health and wellbeing, and what behaviors you may need to change to reduce the risk of disease.
